PER CURIAM.

We have for review <u>Collins v. State</u>, 12 So. 3d 227 (Fla. 2d DCA 2009) (table), in which the Second District Court of Appeal cited as authority its decision in <u>Sheppard v. State</u>, 988 So. 2d 74 (Fla. 2d DCA 2008), <u>quashed</u>, 17 So. 3d 275 (Fla. 2009). At the time the Second District issued its <u>Collins</u> decision, <u>Sheppard</u> was pending review in this Court. We have jurisdiction. <u>See</u> art. V, § 3(b)(3), Fla. Const.; Jollie v. State, 405 So. 2d 418 (Fla. 1981).

We stayed proceedings in this case pending our disposition of <u>Sheppard v.</u> <u>State</u>, 17 So. 3d 275 (Fla. 2009), in which we ultimately quashed the Second District's underlying <u>Sheppard</u> decision. We then issued an order directing respondent in the present case to show cause why we should not accept jurisdiction, quash the Second District's underlying <u>Collins</u> decision, and remand for reconsideration in light of our decision in <u>Sheppard</u>. Respondent in its response concedes that it can show no such cause.

We have accordingly determined to accept jurisdiction and grant the petition for review in the present case. The decision under review is quashed and this matter is remanded to the Second District for reconsideration upon application of this Court's <u>Sheppard</u> decision.

It is so ordered.
