The Second District recently issued *Ewing v. State*, Case No. 2D09-6020 (Fla. 2d DCA Feb. 25, 2011), in which the court informed the Committee for Standard Jury Instructions of a potential problem with the sale, purchase, manufacture, delivery, or possess with intent instruction.

The alert on the Committee's website shows that the Committee is reviewing that instruction. If so, the Committee may also want to review the boxes of lesser-included offenses for the trafficking instructions – which are very similar to the box of lesser-included offenses in Instruction 25.2.
