The Rules Committees have reviewed and considered the Courthouse News Service's comment. The Committees agree that, as a general matter of policy the Court's rulemaking function should not diminish the ability of citizens or the media to have access to court records. However, the concerns raised in the comment, which focus on substantive issues regarding the media's ability to gain timely and low-cost access to filings after documents are e-filed, are beyond the scope of procedures for e-filing, which the Rules Committees were directed to formulate, and thus we take no specific position on the comment.
