### **Petition**

The Florida Board of Bar Examiners petitions the Court for approval of an amendment to the Rules of the Supreme Court Relating to Admissions to the Bar.

### **Jurisdiction**

The Court has jurisdiction of this matter pursuant to Article V, Section 15 of the Florida Constitution and Rule 1-12 of the Rules of the Supreme Court Relating to Admissions to the Bar.

# **Summary and Discussion of Proposed Rule Amendments**

The board recommends a change to rule 1-21. As presently worded, the rule sets the membership of the board at 15 members, comprised of 12 attorney members and 3 public members. The recommended change allows the board to petition the Court for additional members to serve on the board, as necessitated by fluctuating workload.

### **Effective Dates of Proposed Rule Amendment**

Should the Court adopt the proposed rule amendment, then the board requests that it be made effective immediately. In addition, the board requests that the Court appoint 2 additional lawyers and 1 additional public member, with terms to begin on November 1, 2015, and such terms to be for the duration specified in rules 1-22.3 and 1-23.3 of the Rules. These additional positions on the board will terminate at the conclusion of these terms unless the board petitions the Court to continue the additional positions beyond these terms.
