To the Sheriff of the Supreme Court of said State—GREETING:

WHEREAS, on the petition of W. B. Pickett as Sheriff of Duval County, Florida

alleging that in the record and proceedings, and also in the rendition of the judgment in a certain prosecution in the Circuit Court of the Fourth Judicial Circuit, in and for the County of Duval, ~~by~~ where in Andrew Patterson petitioned for a writ of Habeas Corpus directed to W.
