IN THE MATTER OF:

By memorandum dated December 20, 1983, counsel for Ms. moved for reconsideration of the decision of the Board of Appellate Review rendered November 17, 1983, in the matter of the citizenship appeal of matter.

In its decision of November 17, 1983, the Board affirmed the previous administrative determination of the Department of State that expatriated herself on January 27, 1976, under the provisions of section 349(a) (1) of the Immigration and Naturalization Act by obtaining naturalization in Canada upon her own application.

The Department of State on January 30, 1984, filed a memorandum in opposition to the motion for reconsideration.

Upon examination of appellant's motion for reconsideration and the Department's memorandum in opposition, it is our view that the motion fails to disclose any points of law or fact that the Board may have overlooked or misapprehended in reaching its decision, or any new matters that would warrant reconsideration of its decision.

Accordingly, appellant's motion for reconsideration of the Board's decision of November 17, 1983, is denied.
